Reformation hits 500

Church commemorates half millennium anniversary of Martin Luther's '95 Theses'

On All Hallows Eve 500 years ago, Martin Luther, professor of moral theology at the University of Wittenberg in Germany, posted his famous "95 Theses." This document featured his thoughts about some questionable practices of the Holy Roman Church. That simple action began the Protestant Reformation. The "95 Theses" was a collection of 95 points written to dispute the power of indulgences sold by the church. At the time, plenary indulgences could be purchased from church officials. These certificates supposedly granted forgiveness from sins. Luther proposed in his document that these indulgences led Christians to avoid true repentance, instead purchasing forgiveness.

Luther sent the "95 Theses," along with a letter, to the Archbishop of Mainz on October 31, 1517, a date considered to be the start of the Reformation and celebrated annually as Reformation Day. It is widely believed (and a tradition at the University of Wittenberg) Luther also put a copy of his theses on the door of All Saints Church and other churches around the town. The theses was quickly reprinted and spread throughout Germany and Europe. The "95 Theses" also prompted a "pamphlet war" with indulgence preacher Johann Tetzel. This spread Luther's word even farther. One man stood against what he saw as corruption of the establishment. Luther's fight was, of course, one of theology. But it was still one man, against the massive Holy Roman Empire. Luther was threatened, excommunicated and labeled a heretic. But his teaching grew in popularity throughout his life. Those who follow Luther's teachings number in the millions. Most Protestant churches today trace their heritage to the teachings of Luther. Luther's writings on the freedom of the Christian to serve the government, and the role of the government to establish justice and to protect citizens, have greatly influenced views on authority. Though he was a theologian, Luther wrote and thought about all of life. He was concerned for the children in his town. He was involved in the politics of his day. He was an academic. He was a family man. He was a revolutionary. He was involved in the lives of the common man. Yet this Reformation anniversary is not a celebration of Luther. Lutheran does not mean a follower of Luther himself, but of his theological teachings. Luther cared for and worked to provide materials for the people of his town, writing the "Small Catechism" to teach the basics of the faith, and translating the Bible into German to increase the book's accessibility to laypersons. The German language exists as it does today at least in part due to Luther's translation of the New Testament. The Platte Valley Lutheran Church will be hosting a special Reformation Service 7 p.m. on October 31 at 514 South First Street in Saratoga. The service will include readings from Luther and the singing of some of Luther's Hymns. Pastor of the Platte Valley Lutheran Church, Randolph Schnack, says of the service, "It will pretty low key in the sense of it will be a hymn, reading, short message, hymn, reading, short message." Schnack invites the entire community to come and share in this event and plans to have an English language version of the "95 Theses" on the door of the church.
