younger wrestlers which could do well in the future. The team had their first matches at Lusk although Richardson said his team was down to four wrestlers because several others could not make the meet. "Robbie (Marta) wrestled aggressively and although the results don't exactly show it, his effort was fantastic," Richardson said. Marta wrestled at 126.

Richardson said he was proud of the effort by all the wrestlers. He said because it was their first matches, mistakes were made that cost the wrestlers points, but Richardson said mistakes are coachable. "Effort is what matters," Richardson said. "Mistakes are going to happen if a wrestler takes chances to try and get a win." Richardson said McDaniel,

wrestling at 152 did take chances and although he didn't win the majority of his matches, his coach said the wrestler did well. Roberts was at Lusk wrestling at 132, but Richardson said the season could see the wrestler going down to 124. Richardson said effort was apparent with Roberts and since the season was still new, the wrestler would get better results.

"It is the beginning of the season, not the end of the year," Richardson said. "The team would like to put up more points than we did, but we know we are going to have to be in matches before we can get better." Nelson who was 1-2 could have easily been 3-0 Richardson said. "Jon is very athletic and he was winning, but he made some mistakes that are cor-

rectable, so his wins will increase," Richardson said. Richardson is looking forward to this week where his team is set to compete in Hanna. "I really appreciate the community support of me and the team," Richardson said. "They believe in what I teach." HEM will get the opportunity to show their support at 5:30 p.m. on Dec. 14.
