MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE SARATOGA TOWN COUNCIL HELD DECEMBER 6, 2016, AT 6:00 P.M. IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBERS OF THE SARATOGA TOWN HALL

Mayor Ed Glode called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Members present were Councilman Will Faust, Councilwoman Judy Welton, and Councilman Richard Raymer. Councilwoman Susan Howe was absent from the meeting

APPROVAL OF AGENDA: Councilwoman Welton made a motion to approve the agenda as presented. Councilman Raymer seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES: Councilman Faust made a motion to approve the minutes of the November 15, 2016 meeting as presented. Councilman Raymer seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

APPROVAL OF THE BILLS: Treasurer Sammy Flohr read the following bills for approval: Accounts Payable: \$69,165.56; Payroll and FICA in the amount of \$49,486.44; and manual checks including the November Liabilities in the amount of \$65,523.52 for a total of \$184,175.52.

Councilman Faust made a motion to pay the Prairie Dog Electric bill in the amount of \$175.22. Councilwoman Welton seconded and the motion carried.

Councilman Faust made a motion to pay the Shively Hardware bill in the amount of \$1,745.25. Councilwoman Welton seconded and the motion carried. Mayor Glode declared a conflict and abstained from voting.

Councilman Faust made a motion to pay the remaining bills in the amount of \$182,255.05. Councilwoman Welton seconded and the motion carried.

CORRESPONDENCE: Mayor Glode read a letter from the Carbon County Visitors Council thanking the Town of Saratoga for the support of the CCVC and the 2016 activities and events in Carbon County. The letter reviewed the successes and achievements of the CCVC during 2015-2016.

REPORTS FROM DEPARTMENTS:

Town Hall: Mayor Glode reported that the LGLP official board ballot was included in the council packets and encouraged the council to review the ballot for the next council meeting.

Fire Department: No report

Police Department: Police Chief Bifano reported that Dispatcher Cindy Talbott has nearly finished her training at the academy and Officer Christen continues training with Officer Phillips.

Chief Bifano reported that he continues to work with Union Telephone to resolve the E911 system billing issues and that he is nearly done with the revisions to the police department policies and procedures.

Recreation Department: Recreation Director Lisa Burton reported that the Basketball Clinic-skills class had 60 participants and four high school students assisted with the clinic.

Director Burton added that the Ladies Night Out will be held on Thursday, December 8th .

Department of Public Works: DPW Director Jon Winter reported the following:

Street Department: Trimmed tree limbs and bushes on snow plow routes to prevent broken trees and bushes and equipment damage

Snow plowing and maintenance on equipment

WYDOT inspected the Saratoga Inn green bridge and approved the weight posting.

Routine maintenance on downtown sidewalks and parking lot restrooms

Discussed the low water crossing to Veteran's Island with DEQ and it was determined that if the town needed to be doing maintenances on the island no turbidity waver will be necessary

Water & Sewer: Lagoon monitoring wells sampled

Annual samples taken and TC samples sent to EPA

Worked on installation plan for level sensors upgrade at the lagoon wet well

Contacted Timberline Electric to trouble shoot the SCADA system issues. Upgrading the SCADA software and computer system will need to be done in the near future

Gathering information for the tank mixer, a new vent, tank cleaning and leak repair options on the bolted tank

Discussed the WSFR loan and MRG Grant for the treatment pipeline project with the SLIB loan manager. Evaluation of the proposals will be done by the joint powers board and once the consulting group is selected and evaluations completed a revised SOW will be submitted to SLIB for their March meeting

The crew continues to camera sewer lines
