## Invitation to Bid Airport Improvements Saratoga Municipal Airport/Shively Field Saratoga, Wyoming

Sealed Bids, entitled "Runway Rehabilitation Project" addressed to the Town of Saratoga, Wyoming (hereafter referred to as the "Sponsor" or "Owner") will be received and publicly opened at the Saratoga Town Hall, P.O. Box 486, 110 East Spring Avenue, Saratoga, Wyoming, 82331, at 2:00 p.m., local time, Thursday, June 15, 2017.

No bids will be received after the above specified hour and date, and bids which are not prepared and filed in accordance with proposal requirements and conditions of the specifications may be rejected. The Owner further reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive irregularities.

The work is generally described as:

Milling plant mix pavement, pavement overlay, grading, drainage, crushed base, pavement marking, medium-intensity runway light replacement, NAVAID installation, seeding, and mulching.

Contract documents are also available for inspection at Shively Field, the Saratoga Town Hall, and the offices of Sage Civil Engineering, 2824 Big Horn Avenue, Cody, WY, and 2725 West Main Street, Riverton, WY.

All bids must be accompanied by a Cashier's Check, a Certified Check or a Bid Bond in the amount equal to not less than five percent (5%) of the total bid amount for all schedules, payable to the order of the Town of Saratoga, Wyoming as liquidated damages in the event said successful bidder shall fail or refuse to execute the contract in accordance with the terms of his bid. After a contract is awarded, the successful bidder will be required to furnish a separate Performance Bond and a Payment Bond, each in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the contract amount.

Buy American preference requirements found in 49 USC § 50101 shall be met by first tier contractors, who are responsible for ensuring that lower tier contractors and subcontractors are in compliance.

The trade restriction clause referenced in 49 CFR Part 30 applies to this project and must be included in all contracts

and subcontracts.

Bidders must certify at the time they submit their proposal that neither it nor its principals are presently debarred or suspended by any Federal department or agency from participation in this transaction, and further agrees to comply with Title 2 CFR Part 1200 and Part 180, Subpart C by administering each lower tier subcontract that exceeds \$25,000 as a "covered transaction."

The Contractor will be required to comply with the wage and labor requirements and to pay minimum wages in accordance with the schedule of wage rates established by the United States Department of Labor as referenced in the Contract.

Bidders shall certify they will provide, or continue to provide, a drug-free workplace in accordance with Title 49, CFR Part 29 and the Drug-Free Workplace Act of 1988.

Bidders are required to submit a Certification of Non-Segregated Facilities prior to award of the proposed contract, including any subcontracts in excess of \$10,000.

The proposed contract is under and subject to Executive Order 11246 of September 24, 1965 as amended, to the equal opportunity clause and the Standard Federal Equal Employment Opportunity Construction Contract Specifications including the goals and timetables for minority and female participation.

Bidders must supply all the information required by the bid documents and specifications.

A pre-bid conference will be held beginning at 1:00 p.m. local time on Tuesday, June 6, 2017 at the Saratoga Town Hall.

### Town of Saratoga Lagoon Upgrades Request For Proposals

The Town of Saratoga is requesting proposals for design and engineering of four upgrade components to the Town's Waste Water Treatment Plant (WWTP) and development of bid packages for each component's construction phase. The four upgrade components include: 1) Replacing nine valves of various types and sizes in lift station dry well; 2) Installation of approximately 510 feet of 12" pipe lifting the lift station discharge pipe approximately 22 feet, requiring vault coring and revised piping. 3) Installation of four (4) Variable Frequency Drives (VFD's) on the aeration systems blowers tied to a Dissolved Oxygen Sensor. This component would include the installation of approximately 3,100 feet of buried pipe to convey air to the aeration system. 4) Installation of a gas chlorine disinfection system at the WWTP discharge, and a flow device at the system discharge (9" parshall flume).
