### Project Announcement Ryan Park Vegetation and Fuels Management Project

**USDA Forest Service Medicine Bow-Rout National Forests, and Thunder Basin National Grassland Brush Creek/Hayden Ranger District Carbon County, Wyo.**

The Brush Creek/Hayden Ranger District of the Medicine Bow National Forest invites your input on the proposed Ryan Park Vegetation and Fuels Management Project which would treat up to 3,000 acres of National Forest System lands, in Carbon County, Wyo.

This project is separate from the ongoing Medicine Bow Landscape Vegetation Analysis. The Ryan Park project decision will utilize Farm Bill categorical exclusion authority, with an open public process for determining the scope of issues to be addressed.

The Ryan Park Vegetation and Fuels Management Project area lies within the Medicine Bow National Forest, which has a high level of mortality in mature lodgepole pine due to the mountain pine beetle epidemic.

This project addresses the need to restore forested lands with declining forest health, accomplish

localized fuels reduction and address public safety concerns due to the increasing number of falling snags. The project would promote a resilient forest through the use of silvicultural harvest treatments including clear cuts, clear cuts with reserves, overstory removal, thinning, prescribed fire, as well as post-harvest treatments including site preparation for natural regeneration or planting of seedlings. The project would maximize the retention of large live trees, as appropriate for the forest type within the designated treatment areas, would prohibit the establishment of permanent roads, and would include decommissioning of temporary roads created by the project within three years of project completion.

This project announcement letter serves to initiate public collaboration and scoping. Scoping is required for all Forest Service proposed actions, including those that would appear to be categorically excluded from further analysis and documentation under the National Environmental Policy Act (36 CFR 220.4[e][1]).

NEPA scoping letters and notices which invite public comment as part of the NEPA process also serve to notify and invite public comment on the proposal as stipulated by the NHPA.

Your comments would be most helpful by March 12, 2018, but will be accepted until March 22, 2018. A public meeting will take place March 15, 2018 at the Brush Creek/Hayden Ranger District at 2171 S WY- 130 Saratoga, WY from 4-7 p.m. More information about this project is available at the Brush Creek/Hayden Ranger District office and at: <https://www.fs.usda.gov/project/?project=53423>.

## PUBLIC NOTICE

In accordance with the provisions of the Wyoming Environmental Quality Act and Chapter 1, Section 1(f) of the Solid Waste Rules and Regulations, the Upper Platte River Solid Waste Disposal District has submitted a closure permit application for a solid waste management facility called the Saratoga #1 Landfill.

This facility will cease disposal activities of municipal waste. The approximate 40-acre facility is located approximately 1.5 miles east of the incorporated Town of Saratoga. More specifically, this facility is located in the SW1/4 SW1/4 of Section 8, T17N, R83W in Carbon County, Wyoming.

The Department of Environmental Quality, Solid and Hazardous Waste Division (DEQ) has reviewed the permit application and determined that it is complete. The DEQ's solid waste rules, in Chapter 1, Section 2 (b)(i), require that the applicant must provide public notice that the application has been determined to be complete and inform the public that there is an opportunity to file comments on the application. This publication provides notice of that opportunity. Additional information on the permit application and the DEQ's completeness review may be obtained at the address below.

Any interested person has the right to file comments on the permit application and the DEQ's completeness review. The period for providing comments shall begin on March 7, 2018 and end on April 13, 2018. Comments must be received by 5:00 PM on the last day of the notice period. Comments on this application must be submitted in writing to the Department of Environmental Quality, Luke Esch, Administra-

tor, Solid and Hazardous Waste Division, 200 W. 17th Street, Cheyenne, Wyoming 82002.

The Department may, at its discretion, conduct a public hearing on this permit application. If the Department elects to hold a public hearing on the permit application, the Department will provide public notice of the hearing. At the hearing, the Department may solicit additional comments on the application.

The Department is now conducting a detailed review of the application to determine if it complies with applicable technical standards for a facility of this type. If the Department finds that the application complies with technical standards, the Department will issue a proposed permit and provide public notice of the proposed permit.

In accordance with the Americans With Disabilities Act, special assistance or alternative formats will be made available upon request for individuals with disabilities.
