**C.U.W. Case #2018-02:** "Little Medicine Bow Wind Energy Project".

Request for a Conditional Use Permit for a Commercial Wind Energy Facility in the Ranching, Agriculture and Mining (RAM) Zone.

**Project Description:** The Little Medicine Bow Wind Energy Project consists of constructing, operating, maintaining and decommissioning up to 13 wind turbine generators, approximately 40 megawatts and all associated components and facilities that are necessary to generate and deliver electricity to the transmission grid. The project includes all associated components and facilities that are necessary to generate electricity and deliver electricity to the transmission grid, including but not necessarily limited to the following major components:

- Wind energy generating systems, including supporting towers, foundations and other associated equipment or structures;
- Approximately 4.6 miles of 230KV overhead transmission line and underground collection and distribution systems;
- Electric transformers and substations;
- Road network, crane pads and staging areas;
- Met towers and wind measurement equipment;

•All accessory uses necessary for operations and maintenance of the Wind Energy Facility, including, on-site utilities, storage, parking facilities, and similar support facilities.

The project area consists of two parcels of state land located, approximately 981 acres in northeastern Carbon County, approximately 15 miles north of the Town of Medicine Bow.
