### NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

The Town of Encampment, Wyoming, will conduct a public meeting **February 14, 2019 at 7:00 p.m. local time, during their regular council meeting located at 614 McCaffrey**

**Avenue.** The purpose of the meeting is to allow citizens to review and comment on the following project.

The Town of Encampment Sewer Lagoon Improvement Project which will include extensive improvements to the headworks, outlet works, and lagoon cells in order to meet water quality compliance requirements currently not met by the Town of Encampment. Specifically, periodic discharge permit limits for BOD and pH are frequently out of compliance due to inadequate treatment. It is anticipated that the upgrades to the treatment process under this project will include installation of an air diffusion system, influent screening equipment to reduce sludge buildup and associated ammonia production, the possible installation of pond cover(s) to increase temperature in order to improve BOD removal and the installation of influent and effluent monitoring equipment as necessary to meet reporting requirements.

At the meeting the Town of Encampment will present the preliminary design of the proposed project and will discuss the estimated cost of the improvements and the plan for funding the improvements. A preliminary plan of improvements, cost estimates and the funding plan can also be reviewed at Encampment Town Hall located at 614 McCaffrey Avenue.

Based on current cost estimates the Town of Encampment intends to borrow \$500,000.00 from the Wyoming Clean Water State Revolving Loan Fund administered by the Wyoming Office of State Lands and Investments. Existing 2008 Specific Purpose Tax and the proposed 2019 Specific Purpose Tax will be used to repay the loan. The Town of Encampment intends to apply for 75% principal forgiveness. The loan terms will be 2.5% and the term of the loan will be 16 years.

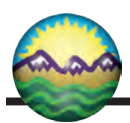

**Notice of Request for a Permit**

Pursuant to provisions of the Wyoming Industrial Development Information and Siting Act and Siting Rules and Regulations, Notice is hereby given that TransWest Express, LLC (Applicant) has filed an Application for a Permit to construct and operate the TransWest Express Transmission Project (TWE Project) in Carbon and Sweetwater Counties. The TWE Project is a high voltage transmission system that will extend across four

states from south-central Wyoming to Southern Nevada. In Wyoming, the TWE Project will include the Northern Terminal, an associated ground electrode, and a converter station, all in Carbon County near the Town of Sinclair. In addition, about 92 miles of transmission line will extend west from the Northern Terminal following the I-80 corridor toward the Town of Wamsutter then turn south to the Colorado state line. The project is located on 4,298 acres of private, state and federal land in both Carbon and Sweetwater Counties. Construction is anticipated to commence in the second quarter of 2020. The transmission line will take approximately 18 months to construct during 2020 and 2021. The Northern

Terminal will be constructed in two stages. Stage I will take approximately 3 years to construct between 2020 and 2022. Stage II construction will take about 3 years to complete (2023 to 2025) but may commence 3 or more years after the completion of Stage I construction dependent on future demand and market conditions. Construction manpower is anticipated to peak at 243 workers in October 2020 and 168 workers in June 2021.
