A regular meeting of the Board of Carbon County Commissioners (BOCC) commenced Tuesday, August 23, 2022, at 2:00 p.m. at the Baggs Higher Education Center in Baggs, WY. Attending the meeting were Chairman, John Johnson, Vice Chairman, Sue Jones, John Espy, Byron Barkhurst and Travis Moore.

Chairman Johnson called the meeting to order at 2:00 p.m.

There were no additions or corrections to the agenda.

Commissioner Espy moved to approve the consent agenda noting any item could be removed for separate action. Tysver Treasurer for the Town of Sinclair in the amount of \$50,000.00. Commissioner Moore seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

ELECTED OFFICIALS & DEPARTMENT HEADS

EXECUTIVE SESSION

Commissioner Espy moved to go into executive session at 2:04 p.m. with Clerk Bartlett and Matt Webster to discuss personnel, potential litigation and other matters considered confidential by law. Commissioner Moore seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

Commissioner Espy moved to come out of executive session at 2:12 p.m. noting no action was taken and that the minutes be signed and sealed. Commissioner Moore seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

Road and Bridge

Commissioner Espy moved to authorize the Chairman's signature on Resolution 2022-36, A Resolution Authorizing the Submission of an Application for Federal Funding through the High Risk Rural Road Program Administered by the Wyoming Department of

Transportation for Carbon County for the Purpose of the Seminole Centerline Marking Project. Commissioner Barkhurst seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

Commissioner Espy moved to approve the Chairman's signature on the Lease Agreement Gravel Permit #525 for County Road 700 with Ron Wille in the amount of \$500.00 per year in a lump sum for 833 tons of aggregate to be removed from the Miller Gravel Pit and thereafter at a rate of \$0.60 per ton for a term of August 1, 2022 through July 31, 2023; and the Lease Agreement Gravel Permit # 425 for County Road 504 with James Wiant in the amount of \$500.00 per year in a lump sum for 833 tons of aggregate to be removed from the Wiant Gravel Pit and thereafter at a rate of \$0.60 per ton for a term of August 1, 2022 through July 31, 2023. Commissioner Jones seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

Building and Grounds

Commissioner Barkhurst moved to approve the lease agreement between Frank Trujillo and Carbon County for the residence located at 523 Rodeo Street, Rawlins for a term of one year beginning on September 1, 2022, and terminating on August 30, 2023, in the amount of \$600.00 per month with a \$200.00 non-refundable pet deposit. Commissioner Espy seconded. Chairman Johnson questioned if this is the same lease agreement as previously used and Clerk Bartlett confirmed only the name and term were different. The motion passed unanimously.

Clerk

Commissioner Jones moved to approve the Health Insurance Plan Renewal with Independence Indigo for reinsurance coverage. Commissioner Moore seconded and the motion passed unanimously. Commissioner Jones moved to approve the Chairman's signature on the Memorandum of Understanding between the Wyoming Office of Guardian ad Litem (GAL) and Carbon County for the purpose of setting forth guidelines for legal representation of children for a term of July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2024, or until terminated and in an amount equal to not less than 25% of fees paid to GAL's. Commissioner Barkhurst seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

Commissioner Moore moved to authorize any commissioner's signature on Resolution 2022-37, Resolution for a Special Prosecutor. Commissioner Espy seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

Commissioners

Commissioner Jones moved to approve the Chairman's signature on the Certification of Substantial Completion for the Replace Wildlife Fence Project at Dixon Airport. Commissioner Barkhurst seconded and the motion passed unanimously. Commissioner Jones moved to approve the Chairman's signature on the Certification of Substantial Completion for the 2022 Seal Coat and Mark Project at Dixon Airport. Commissioner Barkhurst seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

Commissioner Espy moved to adjourn the meeting at 3:25 p.m. Commissioner Moore seconded and the motion passed unanimously.
