C.U. Case #2023-05: Conditional Use Permit in the Ranching, Agriculture and Mining (RAM) Zone to construct, operate, and maintain the Two Rivers Transmission Project (Project). The Transmission Project will transmit the electricity generated to the Freezeout Substation. Two Rivers proposes to construct an overhead 230 kilovolt (kV), single-circuit, alternating-current electric line that will act as a generation tie line ("Gen-Tie") that will connect the Two Rivers Wind Project to the PacifiCorp regional grid at the Freezeout Substation. The Project would traverse approximately 10.6 miles in length and is wholly located within Carbon County on 4.7 miles of Bureau of Land Management administered lands and 6.0 miles of private land.

Notice is hereby given that the Upper Platte River Solid Waste Disposal District (UPRSWDD) will receive sealed Bids for the 2023 LANDFILL ACCESS ROAD IMPROVEMENTS in accordance with the Bidding Documents.

Bids will be received by the UPRSWDD until 1:30 P.M. Local Time May 25, 2023 by the UPRSWDD c/o Craig Kopasz at the office of Engineering Associates, PO Box 370, 211, N. 1st Street, Saratoga, WY 82331 or via QuestCDN online bidding. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The project consists of: HPM pothole/edge patching, approximately 7,720 square yards double chip seal and 300 cubic yards of road base for the landfill access road improvements.

Each Bid must be accompanied by Bid Security payable to the Owner for 5% of the total amount of the Bid, to be forfeited to the Owner as liquidated damages if the Bidder is awarded the Contract and fails to enter into an Agreement with the Owner within thirty (30) days from notification. The Owner may reject any and all Bids and reserves the right to waive minor irregularities in any Bid. Bids shall remain open for forty-five (45) days after the day of Bid opening.

The Contractor shall guarantee all materials, equipment furnished and work performed for a period of one year from the date of final acceptance. The Performance Bond shall remain in full force and in effect through the guarantee period.

The Notice to Proceed shall be issued within thirty (30) days of the execution of the Agreement by the Owner. If the Notice to Proceed is not issued within this period, this period may be extended by mutual agreement between the Owner and the Contractor. If the Notice to Proceed has not been issued within the thirty (30) day period or within any mutually acceptable extension thereof, the Contractor or the Owner may terminate the Agreement on written notice to the other party, and in such case, there shall be no liability under the Agreement or otherwise on the part of either party.

The Contract will be awarded to the lowest Bidder who has met the minimum requirements set forth in Article 3, Instructions to Bidders, and who is determined to be responsible in the sole discretion of the governing body.

The Contact shall be let to the responsible certified resident making the lowest bid, if the certified resident's bid is not more than five percent (5%) higher than that of the lowest responsible nonresident bidder and the resident bidder does not propose to subcontract more than thirty percent (30%) of the work to nonresident contractors. A resident for this purpose must be certified as a resident by the Wyoming Department of Workforce Services prior to bidding upon the Contract. See W.S. 16-6-101, et seq. A resident bidder shall submit a copy of its certificate of residency with its bid. Resident Wyoming laborers, workmen and mechanics shall be used upon all work in this contract whenever possible.

Pursuant to W.S. 16-6-106, "preference is hereby given to materials, supplies, agricultural products, equipment, machinery and provisions produced, manufactured or grown in Wyoming, or supplied by a resident of the state, quality being equal to articles offered by competitors outside of the state."

A regular meeting of the Board of Carbon County Commissioners (BOCC) commenced Tuesday, April 18, 2023, at 2:00 p.m. at the Elk Mountain Senior Center, in Elk Mountain, WY. Attending the meeting were Chairman, Sue Jones, Vice Chairman, Travis Moore, Commissioners John Espy Commissioner John Johnson and Byron Barkhurst.

Chairman Jones called the meeting to order at 2:00 p.m.

Commissioner Barkhurst seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

PUBLIC HEARING - Adoption of Carbon County Unclaimed and Indigent Burial and Cremation Policy

Chairman Jones opened a public hearing at 2:05 p.m. to hear comments on the adoption of Carbon County Unclaimed and Indigent Burial and Cremation Policy. Chairman Jones called for comments for or against the amendments. There being no comments, Chairman Jones closed the hearing at 2:06 p.m.

Emergency Management

Commissioner Moore moved to approve the Chairman's signature on the Memorandums of Understanding between the Town of Dixon and the Carbon County Office of Emergency Management and a separate one for the Town of Baggs for the use of the sandbagger for the purpose of flood mitigation and the benefit of public health and safety. Commissioner Johnson seconded and Commissioner Espy asked if there will be more municipalities asking for a MOU. Mr. Layman stated Encampment may be requesting the same MOU. The motion passed unanimously.

Commissioner Moore moved to authorize Chairman Jones' signature on Resolution No. 2023-15, A Resolution of the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming Issuing a Flood Declaration. Commissioner Espy seconded and Commissioner Johnson asked Mr. Layman to clarify why this is being approved now and not during an emergency. Mr. Layman reported this document allows him to bring outside resources earlier by planning ahead. Because he and others feel there is a greater than 25% chance of flooding this is the time to plan rather than during the emergency. If not needed no action is needed to undo the resolution's approval. The motion passed unanimously.

Road & Bridge

Commissioner Johnson moved to extend both John Deere motor grader warranties for hydraulics for 2 years at \$14,260.00 each and to authorize any commissioner to sign necessary paperwork. Commissioner Barkhurst seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

Commissioner Barkhurst moved to approve Amendment Number One to the High-Risk Rural Roads Program Subrecipient Agreement between Wyoming Department of Transportation and Carbon County for Project #HR23102 - Striping on Seminole Road for the purpose of amending the Buy America Provisions and authorize the Chairman's signature. Commissioner Moore seconded and the motion passed unanimously.
