Marshal is leaning toward a math major - he has an academic scholarship in math for \$52,000, but he has also been thinking about business aviation. On top of that scholarship, Marshal has received the MEP (Math Engineering Physics) Award, which can be up to \$40,000 over four years.

Marshal said he wants to thank everybody who has helped him or given him advice, because he would not be where he is today without them.
