Carbon County School District No. 2, 315 North 1st Street, Saratoga, WY 82331 herein-after referred to as "Owner", will receive sealed bid proposals for the Hanna Elementary School Demolition Project, 300 2nd Street, Hanna, WY 82327.

## DESCRIPTION OF WORK:

The work includes, building demolition and site restoration as outlined in the documents – Demolition for: Hanna Elementary School. Work shall include the demolition of a 2 story school approximately 49,785 square feet in building area, site demolition, demolition of amenities, backfilling and grading as necessary, disconnecting and capping utilities, temporary erosion and sedimentation control measures, spreading topsoil, and hydroseeding.
