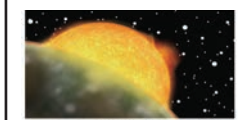

Saratoga's past and present will be revealed during a "Historic Downtown Walking Tour" Saturday, June 11, beginning at 10 a.m. at the Platte Valley Community Center parking lot and concluding with lunch at the Wolf Hotel.

The event is open to the public, and persons interested in participating are asked to register by 9:30 Saturday morning at the Saratoga Museum, 104 Constitution Ave., across from the airport, or call (307) 326-5511.

Cost for the trek, lunch and a printed brochure is \$20 per person for members of the Saratoga Historical & Cultural Assn. (SH&CA) or \$25 for non-members.

The tour is part of the Saratoga Museum's series on "This is YOUR History" and
