The request is to replace the existing 45-foot tower with a permanent 80-foot tower, capable of a 20-foot future extension, with the total structure height being 107 feet including appurtenances, located at Rawlins North Water Tank Communications Site outside of City limits next to the Rawlins Water Tank on the west side of US HWY 287. Sarah Brugger presented the file noting that Union hosted a meeting with various landowners to discuss the location of the tower. Chairman Johnson called for comments for or against the case. There being no comments, Chairman Johnson closed the hearing at 11:29 a.m.

Commissioner Moore seconded and the motion failed with all voting against the motion.
