Wipers work in the engine room when the boat is traveling, and work in the cargo hold when in port.

Main duties of cargo operation are: operating lift trucks; slinging loads; working with lashing chain, chain binders, and dunnage; and sweeping and cleaning cargo holds. This is a fast-paced job, suitable for high-energy individuals.
