## REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS

The Town of Saratoga, Wyoming is soliciting proposals for professional services to assist the Governing Body in updating its Town Master Plan.

The most recent Comprehensive Land Use Plan was completed in 1977, with a street plan being completed in 1978, a Master Domestic Water and Sewer Systems Study in 1978, a Drainage and Street Improvement Study in 1979, an Airport Master Plan in 2014 and a North Platte River Study in 2014. The Master Domestic Water System Study was updated in 2003.

The goal of this process is to develop a Master Plan for the Town of Saratoga with a time horizon of 20 years.

The Saratoga Master Plan Steering Committee will be meeting on April 8, 2015 at 4:00 p.m. at the Saratoga Town Hall. All consultants are invited to attend this meeting to review any materials associated with this project.

## PUBLIC NOTICE STATE OF WYOMING Department of Environmental Quality/ Division of Air Quality Air Pollution Source Draft Operating Permit

Chapter 6, Section 3 (d)(ix) of the Wyoming Air Quality Standards and Regulations provides, prior to final determination on an application for a Chapter 6, Section 3 operating permit, opportunity be given for public comment and public hearing on the information submitted by the owner or operator and on the draft permit. The regulation further requires such information be made available to the public and the public be allowed a period of thirty (30) days to submit comments. A public hearing will be conducted only if, in the opinion of the Administrator, sufficient interest is generated or if an aggrieved party requests a hearing within the 30 day public comment period.

Chapter 6, Section 3 does not impose new substantive requirements on an air pollution source but does require sources subject to the Operating Permit Program obtain a renewable operating permit that clarifies in a single document which air quality requirements apply to the source and provides methods for assessing the source's compliance with those requirements.

Notice is hereby given the State of Wyoming, Department of Environmental Quality, Division of Air Quality, proposes to issue a renewed Chapter 6, Section 3 operating permit to the following applicant for the Saratoga Studmill in Carbon County, Wyoming:

Saratoga Forest Management P.O. Box 1209 Saratoga, WY 82331

The Saratoga Studmill is located in Section 12, Township 17 North, Range 84 West, Carbon County, Wyoming (5 blocks east of North 1st Street in Saratoga). The facility processes a mix of softwood logs to produce kiln-dried, finished, dimension studs. The pollut-

ants of primary concern from this facility are Particulate Matter (PM) and Volatile Organic Compounds (VOCs).

Arrangements can be made with the Division to copy relevant materials, if necessary (a fee will be assessed for reproductions). In accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act, special assistance or alternate formats will be made available upon request for individuals with disabilities. All written comments received by 5:00 p.m. local time (Mountain) on May 1, 2015 will be considered in arriving at a final determination on the issuance of this permit and will be retained on file in the Cheyenne office.
