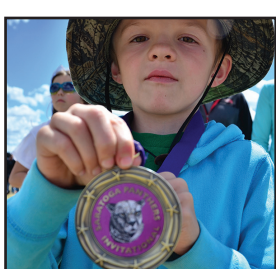

For larvacide, use Liquid Vectobac applied at a maximum rate according to the label.

For adulticide, use Biomist applied at the maximum rate according to the label.

Spraying will begin in June, 2015 within three days notification by a Town of Saratoga representative.

Fixed price to be proposed per acre. Bid shall be made in accordance with this Notice and Call for Bids. The Town of Saratoga requires proof of insurance in the amount of \$500,000 per occurrence coverage to be included in bid documents. Sealed bids will be accepted until 3:00 p.m. on May 14, 2015 in the office of the Town Clerk, P.O. Box 486, Saratoga, WY 82331. Opening of the bids will be held at 3:00 p.m. on May 14, 2015 and will be presented to the Town Council at their regular meeting beginning at 6:00 p.m. on May 19, 2015.

Notice is hereby given that the Town of Saratoga (hereinafter called Owner) will receive sealed Bids for the 2015 Street Improvements Project, in accordance with the Bidding Documents.

The successful Bidder shall perform the Work and furnish a Performance Bond and a Payment Bond, each in the amount of 100% of the contract price with a corporate surety approved by the Owner.

The Contractor shall guarantee all materials and equipment furnished and work performed for a period of one year from the date of final acceptance. The Performance Bond shall remain in full force and in effect through the guarantee period.

The Notice to Proceed shall be issued within thirty (30) days of the execution of the Agreement by the Owner. If the Notice to Proceed is not issued within this period, this period may be extended by mutual agreement between the Owner and the Contractor. If the Notice to Proceed has not been issued within the thirty (30) day period or within any mutually acceptable extension thereof, the Contractor or the Owner may terminate the Agreement on written notice to the other party, and in such case, there shall be no liability under the

Agreement or otherwise on the part of either party.
