Invitation to Bid **Snowplow and Broom** Attachments Acquisition Project Saratoga Municipal Airport Saratoga, Wyoming

Sealed Bids, entitled "Saratoga Municipal Airport - Snowplow and Broom Attachments Acquisition Project" addressed to the Town of Saratoga, Wyoming (hereafter referred to as the "Sponsor," "Owner," or "Buyer") will be publicly opened at the Saratoga Town Hall, 110 E. Spring Avenue, Saratoga, Wyoming, 82331, at 2 p.m. local time, Tuesday, October 15, 2019.

No bids will be received after the above specified hour and date, and bids which are not prepared and filed in accordance with proposal requirements and conditions of the specifications may be rejected. The Owner further reserves the right to reject any and all bids.

The project generally involves furnishing and delivering a folding wing snowplow and an angle broom capable of quick-attachment to a four-wheel drive wheel loader.

All bids must be accompanied by a Cashier's Check, a Certified Check or a Bid Bond in the amount equal to not less than ten percent (10%) of the total bid amount for all schedules, payable to the order of the Town of Saratoga, Wyoming, as liquidated damages in the event said successful bidder shall fail or refuse to execute the contract in accordance with the terms of his bid. After a contract is awarded, the successful bidder will be required to furnish a separate Performance Bond and a Payment Bond, each in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the contract amount.

Preference will be given to Wyoming bidders. The contract will be awarded to the responsible resident making the lowest accepted proposal, if such resident's proposal is not more than 5% greater than that of the lowest responsible non-resident

Preference will be given to materials, supplies, equipment, machinery and provisions produced, manufactured, supplied, or grown in Wyoming, quality being equal to articles offered by competitors outside the state.

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
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
