Sealed bids are being requested by the Board of Carbon County Commissioners (BOCCC) for the following: Supply, Haul & Apply Water & Magnesium Chloride to graveled portions of County Roads 291 & 270. These two roads will need to be watered prior to magnesium chloride application. The project will require one (1) application of magnesium chloride applied at ½ gallon per square yard 24' wide to 55 miles. Contractors are responsible for all traffic control, signage, watering & equipment. Contractors must follow all local, state, and federal laws, including Title 48: Federal Acquisition Regulations System. Contractors will be required to be fully bonded for the project. The project will begin North of Hanna Wyoming on County Road 291 at milepost 3.5 where asphalt ends to milepost 53 where asphalt begins again.
