The Commission will take oral comments, review written comments, listen to the views of all interested parties concerning the proposed wind energy project, and certify their recommendation to the Carbon County Board of County Commissioners.

The Board will take oral comments, review written comments, and listen to the views of all interested parties concerning the proposed wind energy project.

C.U.W. Case #2021-01: Request for a Conditional Use Permit-Wind for a Commercial Scale Wind Energy Facility in the Ranching, Agriculture and Mining (RAM) Zone. The request is to allow the applicant (Rock Creek Wind, LLC and Invenergy LLC) to install, construct, operate, and maintain the "Rock Creek Wind Energy Project" in Carbon County, Wyoming.

Project Description: The Rock Creek Wind Energy Project (Project) is planned to span across both Albany and Carbon Counties. For Carbon County's portion, the Project consists of constructing, operating, maintaining, and decommissioning up to approximately 15 wind turbine generators and all associated components and facilities that are desirable to generate electricity and deliver electricity to the transmission grid.

Overall, the Project has a potential of generating up to approximately 590 megawatts and includes all wind energy system components associated with the wind turbine generators. The Project includes all associated components and facilities that are necessary to generate electricity and deliver electricity to the transmission grid, including but not necessarily limited to the following major components:

- Wind energy generating systems, including supporting towers, foundations, and other associated equipment or structures;
- Overhead and underground electrical distribution, collection and, transmission systems;
- Electric transformers and substations;
- Energy storage facilities, and all of the interconnection facilities;
- Telecommunication equipment, lines and facilities;
- Road network, crane pads and staging areas;
- Met towers and wind measurement equipment;
- On-site Utilities such as water supply and treatment and sewage treatment;
- All accessory uses necessary for operations and maintenance of the Wind Energy Facility, including an operations & maintenance center, storage, parking facilities, and similar support facilities.

Petitioners: Rock Creek Wind, LLC and Invenergy LLC (Applicants) and Various Land Owners (Private and State Lands)

Application Area/General Location: The Application Area will span across Albany and Carton Counties and is planned to occupy approximately 14,900 acres in Carbon County (32,620 acres in Albany County, for a total of 47,520 acres) of open rangeland in the eastern portion of Carbon County, near the Arlington and McFadden region; south of WY HWY 13 and north of Cooper Cove Exit and I-80.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Saratoga Cemetery District, hereinafter referred to as Owner, is accepting sealed bids for design and installation of a commercial sprinkler system for the "Third Addition to the Saratoga Cemetery".

The successful Bidder shall provide the design for the "Third Addition to the Saratoga Cemetery", approximately 2.4 acres. The design and layout of the system shall be reviewed and approved by the Owner prior to installation. The proposed irrigation system shall consist of PVC piping of various sizes, Hunter controls, valving, and sprinkler heads, a two wire system, and a booster pump, of sufficient size to provide satisfactory watering of all areas. Limit number of sprinkler heads on each zone to six. Controls shall be located at the power pole on the northeast side of the construction area. Sealed Bids will be accepted at the Saratoga Town Hall, 110 E. Spring Avenue, Saratoga, Wyoming until 5:00 p.m., Local Time, on October 12, 2021. Bids will be opened at 6:00 p.m. at the Platte Valley Community Center, 210 West Elm, Saratoga, Wyoming in the Donnan Room at the regularly scheduled Saratoga Cemetery District meeting.

Notice is hereby given that the Carbon County Road & Bridge (hereinafter called Owner) will receive sealed Bids for the County Road 15 Culvert Replacement Project, Cooper Cove, Wyoming, in accordance with the Bidding Documents. Bids will be received by the Owner until 10:00 A.M. Local Time, the 18th day of October 2021, at the Carbon County Courthouse, County Clerk's Office, 415 West Pine Street, Rawlins, WY. Bids will be publicly opened. The work shall consist of a culvert replacement, road reconstruction, and other related items. The Owner may reject any and all Bids and reserves the right to waive minor irregularities in any Bid. Each Bid must be accompanied by Bid Security payable to the Owner for 5% of the total amount of the Bid, to be forfeited to the Owner as liquidated damages if the Bidder is awarded the Contract and fails to enter into an Agreement with the Owner within thirty (30) days from his notification.
