**C.U.W. Case #2021-01:** Request for a Conditional Use Permit-Wind for a Commercial Scale Wind Energy Facility in the Ranching, Agriculture and Mining (RAM) Zone. The request is to allow the applicant (Rock Creek Wind, LLC and Invenergy LLC) to install, construct, operate, and maintain the "Rock Creek Wind Energy Project" in Carbon County, Wyoming.

**Project Description:** The Rock Creek Wind Energy Project (Project) is planned to span across both Albany and Carbon Counties and will utilize Private and State Land. For Carbon County's portion, the Project consists of constructing, operating, maintaining, and decommissioning up to approximately 15 wind turbine generators and all associated components and facilities that are desirable to generate electricity and deliver

electricity to the transmission grid. Rock Creek Wind is an Invenergy owned wind project.

Overall, the Project has a potential of generating up to approximately 590 megawatts and includes all wind energy system components associated with the wind turbine generators. The Project includes all associated components and facilities that are necessary to generate electricity and deliver electricity to the transmission grid, including but not necessarily limited to the following major components:

- Wind energy generating systems, including supporting towers, foundations, and other associated equipment or structures;
- Overhead and underground electrical distribution, collection and, transmission systems;
- Electric transformers and substations;
- Energy storage facilities, and all of the interconnection facilities;
- Telecommunication equipment, lines and facilities;
- Road network, crane pads and staging areas;
- Met towers and wind measurement equipment;
- On-site Utilities such as water supply and treatment and sewage treatment;
- All accessory uses necessary for operations and maintenance of the Wind Energy Facility, including an operations & maintenance center, storage, parking facilities, and similar support facilities.

**Application Area/General Location:** The Application Area will span across Albany and Carbon Counties and is planned to occupy approximately 14,900 acres in Carbon County (32,620 acres in Albany County, for a total of 47,520 acres) of open rangeland in the eastern portion of Carbon County, near the Arlington and McFadden region; south of WY HWY 13 and north of Cooper Cove Exit and I-80.

**C.U.W. Case #2021-02:** Request for a Conditional Use Permit for a Commercial Wind Energy Facility in the Ranching, Agriculture and Mining (RAM) Zone. The request is to allow the applicant (PacifiCorp) to repower the "Foote Creek North Wind Energy Facility" (Project).

**Project Description:** Currently the Project consists of 64 wind turbines and pad sites. The applicant plans to replace the 64 wind turbines with 11 new turbines. The nameplate capacity will increase from 43.34 MW to 46.2 MW. However, the total Project capacity interconnected to the transmission system will remain unchanged at 43.35 MW consistent with

the existing Large Generator Interconnection Agreement (LGIA). The Project includes all associated components and facilities that are necessary to generate electricity and deliver electricity to the transmission grid. The existing O&M/control building, maintenance yard(s), staging yard(s), storage area(s), substations, and related facilities and equipment will remain unchanged.

**Application Area/General Location:** Northeast Carbon County; near Arlington and primarily to the north of I-80 and west of State Highway 13.
