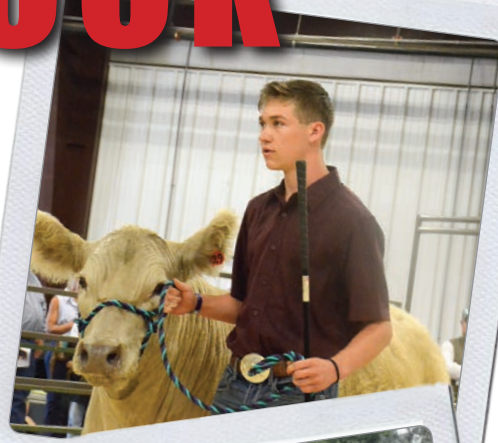

## Breeding a working dog

**Clyde Johnson  
shares advice on  
cattle dogs**

Clyde Johnson, an Elk Mountain rancher, has been involved with the breeding of cattledogs for over 40 years. He has also been heavily involved with the competitions that have sprung up all over the country.

"There are two types of trials that cattledogs compete in," Johnson said. "There is the foot competitions where the handler stays on the ground giving the signals, then there is the rodear version where it is done on a horse."

According to the Rodear America Cowdog Association, rodear is a point and time event wherein the stock knowledge and skill of the dog, rider and horse are put to the test. The competition centers around maneuvering a small group of cattle through a number of obstacles in a set amount of time.

The goal of the rodear event is to revolutionize modern cattledog

competition by most accurately simulating the way in which cow dogs are utilized in everyday cattle operations on working cattle ranches.

Johnson made the point that most cattle operations take care not to harass and "run the weight" off their cattle, the rodear places a great deal of emphasis on the stockmanship of the handler and the quiet and controlled manner in which the dog maneuvers the cattle.

"The reason we do this to that level of stockmanship is to make it better for the consumers," Johnson said. "That is the bottom line at these competitions, we are just trying to handle cattle or any kind of stock, as calmly and quietly as we can, so people get better products."

The event is unique from other cow dog competitions in that the majority of the obstacles require both the dog, horse and rider to negotiate. For this reason, use of the horse is not restricted in any way. With the handler on horseback, rodear provides an opportunity for individuals to enjoy their good cow horses and

work their good cow dogs through courses that either take place in an arena or cross country. Utilizing the horse has made the rodear event attractive to the ranching community

because cattle is herded by horse or ATVs.

"On sage brush, you have to use horses," Johnson said. "On the irrigated meadows, the bogs make it impossible

for ATVs and I use horses then. The dogs like the ATVs because when they get tired, they catch a ride from me. It is good not where them out."

Although cattledog competitions started in the 1980s, the handlers did it all on foot. Rodear started much later.

The first major rodear took place in Fort Klamath, Oregon in 2005. Today, rodears are gaining popularity across the United States, with clinics and competitions being held from California to Texas.

The rodear ultimately brings together the cattledog and the cow horse in an event designed to capitalize on the stock sense and maneuverability shared by both.

Besides the competitions becoming popular over the recent years, there is an association that represents the interests of this valued dog.

The National Cattledog Association (NCA) is a non-profit corporation. The NCA was incorporated in December 2011 and began operations

in January 2012. Its members, which are from 31 states and Canada, are primarily ranchers, cattledog handlers and cattledog breeders.

The NCA said it was founded to educate ranchers as to the value of well trained cattledogs for humane, low stress cattle handling through demonstrations, clinics and public cattledog competitions. It was also formed to assist ranchers in obtaining well trained cattledogs and in learning to use them for efficient, humane and low stress cattle handling.

The NCA fosters amateur athletic competition by sanctioning cattledog trials and hosting and managing a National Cattledog Association National Finals and assist members and other breeders in marketing cattledogs by providing venues for demonstrating the abilities of their dogs.

Johnson has been breeding cattledogs for decades. He and Juan Reyes, a rancher out of Wheatland, started trying different lines several

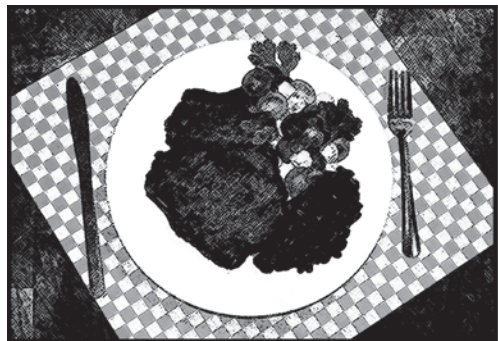

decades ago.

"We were buying dogs together from places like Scotland and Australia, trying to figure out which dogs were better for cattle," Johnson said. "Most dogs are softer and better for sheep. We were looking for a little stronger dog for cattle. A cattledog has to nip at heels of the cow, where when doing sheep, there is a softer touch. That is how the breeding started and now dogs are specifically bred for cattle."

Johnson made clear a great cattledog is not cheap.

"They can run \$10,000 to way more," Johnson said. "I have a friend in California that just sold one for \$45,000."

Johnson said the first pup he started working with as a cattledog was named Ben.

"He actually trained me," Johnson said. "There are international commands that Ben already knew and he just waited for me to give them."

Johnson had Ben for five years.

"I got him middle aged and he was a good dog, but he passed away from cancer five years later," Johnson said. "I had one cattledog that was ranked 5th nationally. She came from champion dogs too."

Dogs can work other animals in a variety of ways. Some breeds, such as the Australian Cattledog, typically nip at the heels of animals and for this reason they are called heelers.

Other breeds, notably the Border Collie, get in front of the animals and use what is called strong eye to stare down

the animals. They are known as headers. The headers, or fetching dogs, keep livestock in a group. They consistently go to the front or head of the animals to turn or stop the animal's movement. The heelers or driving dogs keep pushing the animals forward. Typically, they stay behind the herd.

Johnson said that Border Collies in particular are extremely intelligent.

"They are so smart, they could probably make your coffee in the morning if you asked them," Johnson said. "But they have been with humans a long time working with shepherds."

The rancher explained the massive spread of sheep breeding as man evolved with an increase in of cultivated land. The main task of herding dogs was to protect crops from harm during grazing and moving herds. Medium sized dogs were more suitable for this work. Such dogs managed small and large livestock.

Herding dogs are strong and have a lot of stamina. Their paws are well protected from thorns and sharp stones: toes are compressed into a tight lump, paw pads are thick, claws are strong. The coat has structure and density to protect from getting wet and temperature extremes common in the region of the breed origin. All herding dogs have excellent eyesight and hearing. Cattledog colors are varied and depend on local breeders preferences, but all dogs should have well-pigmented eyelids, lips, nose and paw pads.

Johnson said he and Reyes tried a lot of

experimentation.

"A super cattledog may come in only about every three litters from a great lineage," Johnson said. "About half of a litter may not even be able to be cattledogs and then the other half, there may be only one or two that are good cattledogs."

Johnson said the reason cattledogs have become so popular with ranchers recently compared to times past is that cowboys were plentiful until about the 1970s. The dirth of cowboys opened up a spot for cattledogs.

"I can run 4,000 cattle and I have 10 dogs at the ranch," Johnson said. "I may only use three at a time, but you need the numbers of well trained

dogs to give rest when needed. You can't run them into the ground."

A name that Johnson said has been key in getting the competition going was Jim Chant of Baggs.

"I call him the godfather of dog trials," Johnson said. "He got all these little dog trials going and got a series going at all these county fairs years ago. Now they have changed and advanced but back then we called it the I-80 series because they took place in Nebraska, Wyoming and Colorado."

Johnson was very involved with Chant in the beginning and has watched the trials (competitions) take off over the years from its

humble beginnings.

"At first the cattledog trials were like what it was for sheep trials because there have always been a lot of them at county fairs but, as time went on, now the trials are geared for more for cattle," Johnson said. "Cattle don't do what sheep do and how you move them."

Johnson said cattledogs trials that are like what is offered at the Carbon County Fair are important for the layman to see.

"People who think we beat on cattle all the time can come watch and see that we take care of these animals," Johnson said. "Yes, we kill them, that is what they are raised for, they are a product, but we try to do it as quietly and

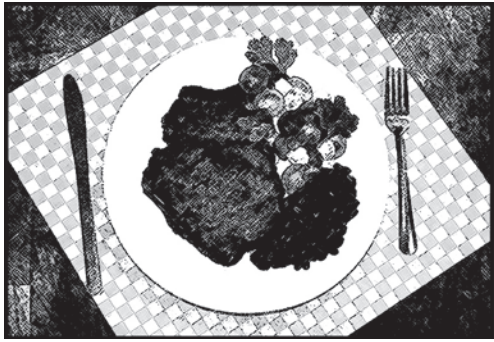
effectively and humanely as possible. Most of these cattle have pretty good lives. Just one bad day."

Johnson said cattledogs are an essential component to raising stock in this age.

"We are trying to perfect a craft in raising our livestock," Johnson said. "Cattledogs are making it easier and these dogs that are competing are just showing how we do it."

As Johnson walked away to get ready for the competition at the Carbon County Fair, his cattledog Moon, who had been silently by his side the entire time he talked, followed him.

## Stockwell back-to-back at State Fair

**Josiah Stockwell gets second State Grand Champion in swine**

Josiah Stockwell may only be a sophomore at Saratoga Middle High School, but already the young fair competitor has made a name for himself with his award winning swine.

Josiah, who took grand champion at the Carbon County Fair last year and reserve champion this year, is also the back-to-back State Grand Champion with his swine. Having been involved with raising swine for the past several years, the soft-spoken young man has some experience in his

division.

"I think what the judges enjoyed most about our pig is that he had a lot of look, he was a very, very pretty show pig," said Josiah. "When he walked into the ring, he got the judge's attention. There was just a lot about him that was hard to deny and there wasn't much that you couldn't like about the pig."

This year's winner was a dark cross barrow and Josiah was excited the good looking pig secured him a back-to-back grand champion award from the state judges. He's hoping his luck will continue into next year and, perhaps, make it a three-peat.

"It's definitely a really, really good feeling," said Josiah. "After the long

days everyday in the summer, and even before the summer, it definitely feels good know all that hard work finally pays off in the end."

For those who are looking at getting into showing pigs, whether they are experience fair competitors or doing it for the first time, Josiah has some advice.

"The person that you buy from, make sure that they really know what they're doing. If it's your first year, hopefully the people that you buy from will be there to help you out," Josiah said. "It takes a long time to know what you're going to do and how to feed and how to train."

## Grand Champion Jalapeno

**Crayfish pocket pet entry takes top spot**

While there appears to be a category and class for just about anything and everything at the Carbon County Fair, some animals don't have a specific category just for them. Fortunately, there's one division they can still enter; pocket pets.

What can sometimes serve as a division for those who are unsure as to the level of commitment to larger or more time consuming animals, the pocket pets division has seen entries in the past ranging from hamsters to bearded dragons to even a beta fish. This

year, however, the Carbon County Fair may have

seen it's first crayfish entry. Elsy Wazelle, a young

Rawlins resident, entered the pocket pets division

for her first year with her crayfish, Jalapeno. The aptly named green crayfish was caught by Elsy in the North Platte River in Saratoga just a few weeks before the fair.

"I've just fallen in love with him," said Elsy. "We have birds and turtles and stuff, but this is the only pet that's mine and nobody else's so I figured I'd do him."

As part of the judging, Elsy had to explain how to determine the sex of the freshwater animal and what it ate. "On the bottom of them, kind of where their tail begins, if they have a splotch of color—normally it's red—if they have that color it's a male but if they don't it's a female," Elsy said. "They're

pretty simple. They eat worms. We have a turtle, so we have a lot of extra turtle food so normally I feed it turtle food." Being such a small animal, Jalapeno doesn't eat much. According to Elsy, the crayfish eats half of a worm each day. Another thing Elsy discovered in her research of the animal was they have a lifespan of five to eight years.

"I'm surprised crawfish actually live that long," said Elsy.

The involvement in pocket pets appears to have gone down in recent years, such that Elsy was the only entrant in the open class division. Owning a Grand Champion crayfish, however, can certainly earn some bragging rights.

## A well rounded competitor

**From cats to dairy goats to steer, Bayla Berger keeps busy**

At the Carbon County Fair, it is not uncommon to see young competitors work with a variety of animals. While there are those who may show specific animals, others have a number of categories they compete in.

One such example is Bayla Berger, a 10 year old Saratoga resident and daughter of Kyle and Stacy Berger. Bayla has been competing at the Carbon County Fair for three years, when she turned 7 years old and was able to do so. While her first animal was a market goat, she has since moved on to do market steer and dairy goats, and even showed her barn cat this year.

"This is my first year, so I just kind of brought him in there to do stuff. Sometimes you stretch them out. Well, my cat is huge, so I didn't do that this year," said Bayla. "They

really liked his height, they really liked how fluffy he was, so he won a lot of the competitions that I had him in."

While her large barn cat won longest whiskers and longest tail, it did not win most colorful. According to Bayla, the cat is so large she has to brace herself to hold the animal. Of course, the cat isn't the only large animal this small fair competitor works with, as she also was in the market steer division. Even as some other older competitors seemed to be dragged around by their steers, Bayla had a degree of control over hers.

According to her, the secret is to "have confidence that you are the boss of them, even if you don't feel like it."

The young Berger might be onto something, as she placed 2nd in her class in both Market Steer and Showmanship Beef this year.

Dairy goats are also something Bayla has been showing in recent years, and is something she appears to enjoy.

"My grandma actually keeps them at her place and she breeds them. When you're younger she gives you your own baby and then you start raising your own herd," Bayla said. "

"Then I get to pick my own dairy goats for showing."

Along with the dairy goats, Bayla also has been getting involved in showing horses.

"Last year I was showing a little pony that my grandma and grandpa have and then, after that fair, there was a guy who raised bucking ponies and we'd been trying to get ahold of him for a while. We finally got to see three bucking ponies that I could buy and train on my own.

They were untouched and unbroke and I chose a little bay paint mare and I call her Indiana," said Bayla. "I broke her and this year I won the overall junior high point on her."

She also wrote a book on the topic of breaking her colt and entered it into the Carbon County Fair this year. According to Bayla,

writing the book was easy as she just told her mom what to type and her mom corrected any errors in grammar. She also did a veterinary project in which she used previous cases to examine symptoms and give a diagnosis. Probably the most exciting recent thing she's done, however, is livestock judging.

"I love livestock judging. It might not sound very

fun, but it is a lot of fun," Bayla said. "We would, at first, just have pictures of steer, swine, market goat and sheep on a computer and you would judge which one and you get points for how close you were to the actual judges opinion."

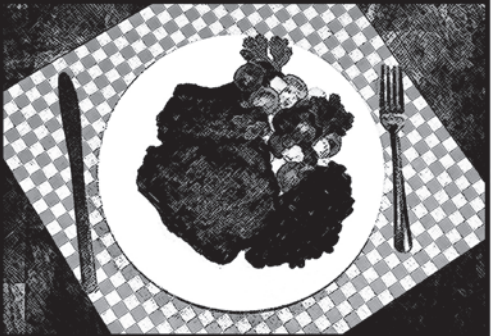
The week of the fair, the livestock judging competition was done in person and Berger also performed well in that

category, earning more points than the seniors, intermediate and adult competitors despite being in the junior class. While she may appear to have a career as a livestock judge, Bayla said she is more interested in becoming a veterinarian when she grows up.

Her time at Carbon County Fair will ensure she's well prepared.

## Life lessons at Fair

### Fair director reflects on 2021 Event

Last year Julie Webb, the director of the Carbon County Fair, had to face many protocols which kept her attendance lower than what she had experienced previous years.

As this year went on and COVID-19 was not abating in Wyoming, she did fear some of the protocols, that limited the size of the Fair, might be implemented again.

Fortunately for Webb and the residents of Carbon County, it did not happen and the Fair was extremely successful.

"Going through what I did last year, helped me

this year," Webb said. "It did prepare me for what could come down the pike, on an emergency basis. Once you have done it, there was the experience of knowing what you could do. Hand sanitizer is a good example. We knew where to find."

Webb said although she didn't like what happened last year, it prepared her for all types of contingencies this year.

"What I noticed this year more than anything else was people were so much more relaxed," Webb said. "I think last year, with COVID, it was like when is the next shoe going to drop, and we didn't have that this year. I think last year gave participants and attendees an appreciation for it not happening again

this year."

She said many families that have kids enter the contests save up all year to attend the Fair and that not having it canceled is a big deal.

"There is so much time and effort put in by these kids in the FFA from all over the county that it is actually the highlight of their year," Webb said. "When we finally had it without the restrictions of last year, you could feel the happiness all around as the Fair went on all week."

She said the sales were a little above average this year with more pigs featured and less lambs. Webb said steers and goats were about the same.

Webb was pleased the operations went

smoothly, but she isn't surprised because of the superintendents of each animal barn.

"The Fair Board really appreciates what the superintendents of the barns do," Webb said. "Without them, we couldn't do what we do. There are two superintendents for the swine barn and there is a superintendent for all the other animal barns. They come in and put in stall assignments for each kid and monitor in the barn all the time, and they make sure the day of the show that the kids are ready. We have a wonderful group of superintendents who have so much knowledge that helps the board. They are volunteer and I, myself, and the board can't praise them enough."

She said the volunteers come from all over the county.

The demolition derby had huge attendance which made Webb happy and she credits Lonnie Pacheco, who took it over this year. However, the memory she treasures most this year was an instance of tremendous kindness at the junior livestock sale.

"We had a 4-H member who lost her mother the day prior, so before this little girl got to sale, three different families had bought her pig and donated it back so it could be resold," Webb said. "So when it got to the sale ring, it sold three more times."

The pig sold six times. Dallin Motors was the final bidder.

"The generous nature of all these people had my eyes leaking as I was watching it happen," Webb said. "Watching Ella (Humphries) and her father (Jared) out in the ring was tearjerking."

In the ring, when the pig was going up for sale, Shively Hardware and Hones Veterinarian Services purchased it. Before the sale, Brad and Gwen Bartlett, Kip Kirbs and Steve Fritz had purchased the pig.

Webb credits the parents for all their efforts to help their kids compete.

"These folk are a good bunch of people," Webb said. "They are raising the kids right. There are a lot of life lessons that go on at the Fair and it isn't just for the kids."
