TITLE 17 SUBDIVISION ORDINANCE

In pursuant to Wyoming Code; notice is hereby given that a Public Hearing will be held by the Town Council of Saratoga.

The Town of Saratoga Planning and Zoning Commission has recently drafted an ordinance that will fully repeal and re-write Title 17 "Subdivisions"; within the Saratoga Town Code. The purpose of the revision is to clarify the process and development requirements when subdividing property or altering existing subdivision boundaries within the Town limits of Saratoga. The revision also clarifies the processes and assurances required when making public improvements during the subdivision process including but not limited to; roads, sewer, water, natural gas, curb and gutter, etc. Prior to recommending the ordinance for adoption to the Town Council, the Planning Commission held a public hearing on January 14th, 2025. The Town Council would like to give the public an additional opportunity to provide feedback on the proposed changes. The Town Council would appreciate any information that could be beneficial in improving this process for the staff, residents, developers, elected officials and residents alike.
